

**Oak Hills Estates Owners Associations  
Rules and Guidelines for Private Events  
Effective June 22, 2026**

If you are hosting a private party or other event at your home in Oak Hills Estates where outside one-time guests will be invited, you must request a temporary gate code for your guests. You can request a specific four-digit code that will be easy for your guests. The temporary access code can be printed on invitations, but gate codes may NEVER be posted at the gate.

The City of Calimesa states that noise and music from events (public and private) must end by 10:00 pm. Even before 10:00 pm, there are limits on noise levels. If police are called multiple times because of noise complaints, substantial financial penalties apply. Refer to Calimesa Municipal Code section 8.15.

If your guests need to park on the roadway, you will need to ensure that cars are parked only one side of the road so that access is not blocked for other traffic and emergency vehicles.

Please include consideration for your neighbors in your celebrations.

*1. A hazardous activity is any activity that could cause serious harm to persons or property, including, but not limited to, threats of physical violence and dog bites. An initial warning shall not be given for hazardous violations. Instead, the Owner will be immediately called to a hearing whereat he/she may be fined and/or subject to other disciplinary action.
